SOLOMON COX 1738 - 1820 Solomon Cox was born a Quaker in York County, perhaps in the township of Warrington, Pennsylvania, sometime prior to 1738. He took a bride by the name of Naomi Amy Hussey.

Being a practicing Quaker meant that he was a non-combatant during the Revolutionary War. Solomon and his wife moved from York County, Pennsylvania to Guilford County, North Carolina where they rendered non-combatant aid to the Patriot Army of General Nathaniel Greene. Later, they moved to Orange County, North Carolina and subsequently on to Hocking County, Ohio. Solomon died in Hocking County on 7 March 1820 and they are both buried there in Hocking County, Ohio.
