Battles: Kettle Creek, GA Kings Mountain and elsewhere under command of General Elijah Clark and Captain Paddy Carr.

Born in Westphalia Germany about 1748. Came to America on ship Patience from Rotterdam on Sept. 9, 1751 to Philadelphia. The family had land grant in Rowan County NC. About 1765 Peter, with a permit to build a grist mill in Wilks County. He settled on Kettle Creek, about 6 miles southwest of Washington, GA, near the battle of Kettle Creek. Peter served both as Calvary and Infantry but generally in Calvary.

Peter volunteered May 1779 at Washington, GA and served until May 1784.
